

Davis is located in Northern California on Interstate Highway 80, 13 miles West of Sacramento, and 56 miles North and East of San Francisco.

San Francisco is a short 2 hour drive from Davis. There are also wonderful recreational areas within reach, such as Lake Tahoe, the Sierra Nevada Mountains, the coastal redwood forest, and the Pacific Ocean. Furthermore, some of the most beautiful national parks are also close by, such as Yosemite and Lassen Volcano National Parks.
