Deadline: January  
Description: Student Fellowships in the social, biological, chemical, physical or engineering sciences relevant to problems of toxic substances in California  
Eligibility: Students currently enrolled in a graduate program on any UC campus are eligible to apply

### **GSA Travel Awards**

Deadline: Spring: May Fall: January

Description: The awards are granted to students attending either professional meetings or any professional development meetings that deal with topics affecting the graduate students' future goals.

Eligibility: GSA members at the time of the application deadline are eligible. You are automatically a GSA member if you are a regularly enrolled graduate student

Description: Three years of support for graduate study leading to research-based master's or doctoral degrees and is intended for students who are in the early stages of their graduate study.

### **Internal Fellowships for Continuing Graduate Students**

Deadline: January 15

Description: Internal Fellowships can provide financial support in the form of a stipend (or "living allowance"), fees, nonresident tuition, research, travel or any combination of these.

### **UC Marine Council Graduate Student Fellowships**

Deadline: February 1

Description: Provides funding for issues pertaining to California's coastal ocean and seeks to address these issues in ways that contribute to increasing our scientific understanding of both natural processes and human-induced changes AND will be useful to legislators, public policy makers and managers who must make decisions for the sustained health of California's ocean.

Eligibility: Students who have completed their first year of graduate studies by the time of application are eligible to apply for fellowship support.

**ACS Graduate Student Fellowship – Analytical Chemistry**

Deadline: December

Description: To encourage basic research in the field of analytical chemistry, to promote the growth of analytical chemistry in academic institutions and industry, and to provide recognition of future leaders in the field of analytical chemistry.

Eligibility: The student applicant must be a full-time student working toward a Ph.D. in analytical chemistry and must have completed the second year of graduate study by the time the fellowship period begins.
